Margaret Wigglesworth is the new executive director of the Boston Society of Architects (BSA), one of the largest chapters of the American Institute of Architects.

Wigglesworth, an experienced association leader, comes to the BSA with a diverse corporate, public and nonprofit background. As founding director of the Coalition of Service Industries, she cultivated partnerships among corporations and policymakers in the U.S. and abroad. Most recently, Wigglesworth has worked with Trinity Church in Boston, developing alternative revenue sources and enhancing giving programs.
