

Washington Trust provides \$9.8 million financing

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New Haven, CT Washington Trust's commercial real estate group provided \$9.8 million in financing to Route 34 Phase I, LLC, for the refinancing of a recently constructed Rite Aid Pharmacy and the completion of a 10,000 s/f retail building in downtown.
