Delphi Construction to begin work on \$16 million Seascape at Weymouth

Weymouth, MA Multi market construction management firm, Delphi Construction will soon begin work on Seascape at Weymouth, a 6-story condominium development at Weymouth Neck.

The project, valued at \$16 million, is owned by DAI Property Management. Design work was provided by Sheskey Architects of Quincy, MA. The team is rounded out by CHA Companies, Veitas and Veitas Engineers, Wozny/Barbar & Associates, and Ryan Associates.

Seascape at Weymouth will complete the residential development of Weymouth Neck. The 50 unit residential building will not only enhance the existing condominium community, but also provide additional benefits to the Town of Weymouth through aesthetic architecture, exceptional landscape design, minimal site impact and positive economic growth.
