

Boylston Properies hires MacEachern as director of construction

MacEachern's immediate principal responsibility is building the \$350 million Arsenal Yards mixed use development, a joint venture with The Wilder Companies. With sitework underway, Arsenal Yards is a one million s/f development of the former Arsenal Mall site in Watertown, into an urban neighborhood, slated to open in spring 2019.
