Braintree, MA The Marr Cos. is expanding operations to a site south of Boston. In 2018, the company acquired 16 acres of land at 201 Commerce Dr. in Liberty Park. One-third of the parcel will serve as the new location for Marr's crane and rigging operations and other products beginning in January 2020. This new site, known as Marr South, will provide conditions for Marr to meet its requirements for near-term growth and the expanding building industry.

The official groundbreaking took place on Flag Day, June 14th. Mayor Sullivan said, "I've come to know the Marr family and I'm so pleased they have chosen Braintree to expand their enterprise. Braintree has attracted good quality businesses and those

companies bring not only employment and revenue, but also a level of vibrancy that helps the community grow. I know that The Marr Cos. will add to that growth and that they will be engaged in our community's civic activities.”

The Marr Cos. has established a management team to develop Marr South that includes the following entities: Choo & Company, Inc.; Civil & Environmental Consultants, Inc.; G & C Concrete Construction; J. C. Cannistraro, LLC; J. Derenzo Co.; Lucas Environmental, LLC; Mount Hope Engineering, Inc.; SPACE Building Corp.; Sullivan & McLaughlin Companies, Inc.; and Sunrise Erectors, Inc.
