

Landmark Structures completes 14-units for Caritas Communities

The \$1.1 million project included the gut/rehab of the 10,000 s/f former MacKenzie Nursing Home into 14 single rooms with private bathrooms and a common kitchen area. The project encompassed all new finishes, doors, windows, roofing, siding and mechanical systems.

The building utilized energy-efficient practices and meets the requirements of Mass. New Homes with Energy Star.

The project received funding from the Commonwealth of Mass.Department of Housing & Community Development and the North Suburban Consortium.

Architect for the project was Russell Scott Steedle & Capone Architects, Inc. of Cambridge.
