The neighborhoods surrounding Coolidge Corner are filled with beautifully designed and maintained apartment buildings, and CHR buildings are often mistaken for condominium buildings.

All of our apartment buildings offer easy access to Coolidge Corner or Washington Square and are meticulously landscaped by Chestnut Hill Realty's horticulture department with a variety of vegetation, including trees, shrubs and flowers.

While St. Paul Gardens is an elegant building, the older and smaller Auburn & Harris structure is even more ornate and distinctive. The building sits on nearly one half acre at Auburn and Harris Sts.

Some units have sunken living rooms, while all have eat-in kitchens and hardwood floors. While most are one bedroom apartments, there also are six exquisite two-bedroom apartment homes.
