

Jones Lang LaSalle sells 102,000 s/f to Cedar Shopping Centers - \$17.6m

Jones Lang LaSalle, has executed the sale of Price Chopper Plaza to Cedar Shopping Centers, Inc. for the purchase price of \$17.654 million. Jones Lang LaSalle managing director Jim Koury and associate Nathanel Heald, represented the seller and introduced the buyer.

The plaza totals 102,000 s/f and is located close to the town center at the intersection of I-395 and Rte. 12. Tenants include Price Chopper Supermarket, Fashion Bug, Papa Ginos, D'Angelo's, freestanding CVS and Burger King.
