Ravi's leadership is demonstrated by his role as board member of Delaware Valley Green Building Council (DVGBC) and a founding member and chair of the Emerging Green Building committee of DVGBC.

Srinivasan is a Certified Energy Manager (CEM), a Certified CEM Trainer, and a LEED Accredited Professional.
