

Waters of McLaughry Commercial leases 2,550 s/f

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Bruce Waters, CCIM, senior broker for McLaughry Commercial, negotiated a lease between UVLSRPC and S & W Investment Company, LLP, owners of 10 Water St. The building was originally built as part of the American Woolen Mill Company. The facility is going through renovations to accommodate a mix of Upper Valley companies, from office use and fine art studios to many research and development entities.
