Fuller of Jones Lang LaSalle named Property Manager of the Year by BOMA

The building is owned by Tremont Street Realty LLC, and is managed by Carol Griffin. 2 Canal Park was awarded Office Building of the Year in the 100,000-249,999 s/f category. It is owned by TA Associates, and is managed by Jan Reardon. Each year, 2 Canal Park raises funds for the Alzheimer's Association with their "Memory Walk." 100/200 Technology Sq., owned by ARE-Tech Square and managed by Kristina Descoteaux, won the award in the renovated building category. The building recently completed its fourth renovation featuring its conversion from office to laboratory space.
