Always anticipating the needs of the corporate community, the facilities were developed to attract the competitive, innovative world of hi-tech. Other amenities include: formerly a call center, disaster recovery site, reception area / atrium, emergency motor generator, UPS room, board room, small conference rooms, passenger elevator, freight elevator, ample parking, receiving bay, security system installed, easy access ramp, modern lighting, forced hot air gas heat, fully air conditioned, satellite capabilities.
