John Druker founded the family's real estate business, and the company built the Hotels Kenmore and Braemore, The Colonnade Hotel and Residences, the Heritage on the Garden, and Atelier 505. The MFA's \$345 million Art of the Americas Wing opened November 2010 as part of an expansion project.
