

Tamposi and Ball of CBRE/New England complete sale of 189.85 acres - \$1.29 million

CBRE/New England (CBRE/NE) has completed the sale of 39 Charles Bancroft Hwy., a 189.85 acre land parcel. The land traded hands for \$1.29 million.
