

Skanska USA promotes Hurley to executive vice president and regional manager

Skanska USA's commercial development unit has promoted Shawn Hurley to executive vice president and regional manager.

In his new role, Hurley will be responsible for the expansion of Skanska's commercial development activities in the Boston area.
