The home was later purchased by entrepreneur and railroad investor Oliver Ames and his wife, Elise Alger (West) Ames.

In 1946, Frederick Bashaw purchased the townhouse and converted it from a single-family dwelling into a school to be operated by the Boston Business Institute.
