RICS and RIGBC's wind energy presentation to be held on May 16

May 10, 2012 - Rhode Island

Join RICS and RIGBC to learn about the Narragansett Bay Commission's (NBC) Wind Energy Project at Field's Point on May 16 from 5:30-8:00 p.m. Enjoy cocktails on the outdoor patio at the Wyndham Garden Hotel overlooking the turbines in the bay, followed by an in-depth technical presentation from the experts. NBC estimates that three 1,500 kW wind turbines will be capable of supplying between 35 to 45% of the current electrical power demand of the Field's Point Waste Water Treatment Facility (WWTF). The electricity produced by these turbines will offset approximately 3,000 tons/year of carbon dioxide that would have been released from fossil fuel generated electricity.

Topics covered include feasibility study, engineering and construction process, safety and environmental concerns, and ecological impacts.
