Taking part in STEP can also lead to recognition at the national and chapter level. In fact, our chapter's eighth annual STEP awards ceremony is May 17 at Montvale Plaza in Stoneham. On this night, the merit shop industry takes a couple of hours to recognize member companies and their employees for dedicating themselves to jobsite safety and continually improving their safety performance.

The STEP awards are the biggest event of the year for the Gould Construction Institute, Associated Builders and Contractors of Massachusetts' training affiliate.
