

## Two Bulfinch Cos.' buildings earn EPA's Energy Star label

Needham Executive Center is a two-story, 45,312 s/f office building located at 144 Gould St., Needham and is accessible from Rte. 128 via exit 19B.

Created in 1992, Energy Star is a joint program of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Department of Energy that helps to save money and protect the environment through energy efficient products and practices.
