

Abbot Building Restoration restores façade of 3 condo buildings

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Abbot recently completed restoration of the façade of three attached brick condominium buildings at 24-38 Summit Ave.

When these buildings were converted to condominiums in the 1980s, the Condominium Association installed all new replacement windows at that time. Although the windows are technically the responsibility of the condominium unit owners, when the windows recently began to leak, the Condominium Association agreed to recaulk the windows as a courtesy to the condominium unit owners to minimize water seepage into the interior of the units. The Condominium Association hired the architectural consulting firm of Gorman Richardson Lewis to evaluate the situation and provide specifications for the repairs. Selected as the masonry contractor by the consulting firm, Abbot recaulked the entire front facade of all three buildings according to the architectural specifications to improve the water penetration problem.
