

Bowdoin celebrates grand opening of 57,000 s/f Big Y World Class Market

Additionally, the store utilizes many sustainable and energy-efficient amenities including low flow bathroom fixtures, as well as Coulomb auto-charging stations in the parking lot to enable customers to recharge electric vehicles. The charging stations were installed by Nashville based Green Power Technology.
