This was a very significant lease as they took almost 5,000 s/f, signed a very long-term lease and invested a tremendous amount of capital to transform the shell space into a gorgeous Asian restaurant with its popular raised Sushi bar, in addition to the dining areas and full service bar.

Epping Meats & Marketplace followed in 3,600 s/f recognizing there was a need for a butcher shop in the area and Epping Commons was the prime location.

We always had tremendous demand from tenants wanting to be a part of this development but banks weren't lending, equity lines couldn't be obtained, even the SBA wasn't a source of funding. No less than 40 deals with readily willing and able tenants couldn't get to the finished line and finalize a lease. Through mere perseverance we are happy to have achieved this milestone today, four years later."
