

Simon Konover Entity acquires Norwich building

Simon Konover Development Corporation (SKDC) has acquired the building located at 620 West Main St., formerly occupied by Friendly's restaurant.

The former restaurant building, which sits on approximately one acre of land, was renovated in 2011. The property abuts Marcus Plaza which is owned by Norwich Realty Associates, LCC, a Simon Konover-related entity. Marcus Plaza is a community shopping center anchored by Shop Rite and TJ Maxx.
