

Vision 3 Architects breaks ground on six-story parking structure

On October 15, Johnson & Wales University broke ground on their new parking structure. The six-story, 750-car, open parking structure will be located at the intersection of Richmond and Pine Sts. in the DownCity Historic District.

In association with Walker Parking Consultants, Vision 3 Architects' role as image architect includes exterior façade design, coordination of all permitting activities including the Providence DownCity District Review Commission approvals, coordination of sitework and landscape architecture, as well as design of the first-floor commercial space on Richmond St.
