

Belmont Savings finalizes \$5.4 million for Emerson Lofts at Cottage Park

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Belmont Savings Bank recently finalized a \$5.4 million loan to Emerson Lofts at Cottage Park, a 16-unit project. Located at 22 Cottage Park Ave., Emerson Lofts at Cottage Park is an adaptive reuse of a brick factory building using green construction and contemporary high-end finishes.
