

Boston Realty Advisors completes \$12.8 million sale of 43-unit apartment building

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Boston Realty Advisors (BRA) has completed the sale of 52 Westland Ave., a 43-unit apartment building located in the city's Fenway neighborhood for \$12.8 million. The buyer was 52 Westland Enterprises LLC and the seller was 52 Westland LLC.

52 Westland Ave. is a five-story, 43 unit, apartment building, located in the city's Cultural District. The asset benefits from its location across the street from Whole Foods and its adjacency to the Boston Symphony Hall.
