

CBRE completes three leases - 17,206 s/f at High Ridge Park Corporate Center

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As the exclusive leasing agent for High Ridge Park Corporate Center in Stamford, CBRE Group recently signed three leases totaling 17,206 s/f at the six-building, 40-acre property.
