

Chen of Crystal Window & Door elected as president of Northeast Window & Door Association

Steve Chen, executive vice president of Crystal Window & Door Systems, has become the new president of the Northeast Window & Door Association (NWDA). Elected by the association's board of directors, Chen took over the reins of the regional trade group at the organization's winter meeting on January 29.

In addition to his NWDA position, Chen serves on several boards, including a New York Federal Reserve Bank Advisory Council, the board of Directors for Queens Theatre in the Park, and the Queensborough Community College Advisory Board on Continuing Education.

Chen has received many notable business and industry recognitions. Glass Magazine named him a top "20 Under 40" industry executive, the Queens Chamber of Commerce ranked him as one of the borough's "Top Executives Under 40," and he received the "Rising Star" Award from a leading Queens business newspaper.

The Northeast Window & Door Association regionally represents the fenestration industry, offering seminars on the latest technologies and product innovations, as well as speakers on important legislative and regulatory issues impacting the industry. In recent years, the organization has increased its advocacy role, working with key government officials and influencers that help shape the industry and marketplace.
