

Connecticut Comm'I. RIty. and Raveis broker \$1.625m land sale

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Connecticut Commercial Realty has sold a three parcel aggregation of land consisting of 3.33 acres for the construction of a new CVS Pharmacy located on Rte. 32. The site is located directly across Rte. 32 from the recently developed Montville Commons shopping plaza. The firm of Carpionato-LaBossiere Properties, LLC took title to the properties in the name of Montville Realty Partnership, LLC at a total contract price of \$1.625 million.
