

CBRE/New England sells 57,000 s/f Commerce Way Marketplace; Angelone, Moylan, Heald and Lusa represent seller

CBRE/New England's capital markets team has sold Commerce Way Marketplace, a 57,000 s/f retail property located at 112 Commerce Way. Commerce Way Marketplace is 100% occupied by PetSmart, Chipotle and Bob's Discount Furniture - each of these tenants has occupied the property since its construction in 2009.

National Development sold the asset to Integrated Properties in partnership with Turtle Bay for an undisclosed price. CBRE/New England's Chris Angelone, Bill Moylan, Nat Heald and Bruce Lusa represented the seller and procured the buyer in the transaction.
