Many subcontractors who are familiar with North Branch's high-visibility clothing have adopted this policy as well, adding to the overall jobsite safety. North Branch has developed a safety fine program to ensure that their projects are always operating safely. Repeat safety violations by any workers on a North Branch jobsite (including North Branch's own employees) are subject to safety fines which are donated at the end of each year to the non-profit charities and organizations that they work with.
