

Pinsky of Tighe & Bond elected ACEC/MA board of directors - secretary

A frequent speaker at AWWA and NEWWA programs, he has authored numerous technical publications, served on the AWWA Coagulation and Filtration Committee, and chaired the NEWWA Filtration Committee for 11 years.

He also has previously served on the board of directors for the Westfield Chapter of the Red Cross. ACEC/MA is the business association of the Mass. and R.I. engineering profession, representing over 110 independent engineering companies engaged in the development of transportation, environmental, industrial, and other infrastructure. Founded in 1960 and headquartered in Boston, ACEC/MA is a member organization of the American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC) based in Washington, DC. ACEC is a national federation of 51 state and regional organizations.
