NESEA's 2013-14 Student Design Competition was formally launched on August 19.

The competition is focused on Net-Zero Energy design across four competition divisions; commercial and residential, new construction and rehabilitation, and is targeting undergraduate and graduate student design-teams and their faculty advisors from design, engineering and building science colleges and universities throughout the 10 northeastern state that NESEA serves.
