Southern CT BOMA TOBY awards dinner held October 3

On October 3rd, close to 250 people attended the Southern CT BOMA TOBY (The Office Building of the Year) awards dinner at The Water's Edge in Darien. This award recognizes property management excellence and was presented to 33 Benedict Place in the 100,000-249,999 s/f category. Owned by 33 Benedict Place, LLC and managed by Hines Interested Limited Partnership, this property was the judges' choice for a TOBY. Also winning a TOBY was 400 Atlantic in the Earth Category.
