

Related Beal begins plans for Lovejoy Wharf at 131 Beverly Street

Related Beal is planning for a new condominium development at 131 Beverly St. The residential building is part of an overall redevelopment of Lovejoy Wharf Related Beal has undertaken that will transform a long under-utilized 2.1-acre waterfront site into the new world headquarters for Converse Inc., residential and retail uses and a public open space on Boston Inner Harbor.

Designed by Robert A.M. Stern Architects in collaboration with architectural firm ADD Inc, the new 144 foot tall 131 Beverly St. will offer 175 condominium residences reflecting the growing market demand for residential ownership opportunities in the city's newest neighborhood. 131 Beverly is expected to commence construction in fall of 2014 and be completed in fall of 2016.

Robert A. M. Stern Architects is the visionary firm behind The Clarendon and One Back Bay. The residential building is located adjacent to the 10-story new home of Converse Inc.'s world headquarters at 160 North Washington St. Retail will also line Lovejoy Wharf.

Stern Architects and ADD Inc to bring a unique condominium opportunity to market in such an accessible and marquee location on Boston's waterfront. Lovejoy Wharf is located on Boston Harbor between the Zakim Bridge and Charlestown, and is an example of transit-oriented development, which has become the trend in residential projects around the city. The site sits between North Station, which services the entire North Shore, and within walking distance of Government Center, Charles St. and Beacon Hill, the North End and the Charlestown Navy Yard.

The residential development will feature expanded space for bicycle owners, spaces for Zip Cars, and public water transportation from a new restored wharf.
