

Kaplan Construction completes \$1.5 million Tufts Medical Center facility: 15,000 s/f design by Lavallee Brensinger architects

Kaplan Construction completed work on a new 15,000 s/f \$1.5 million Tufts Medical Center building. Located in Crown Colony Park, the new building will house Tufts Medical Center Primary Care - Quincy.

Early involvement in the project allowed Kaplan to provide valuable estimating and value engineering services to both the building owner and architect, while also contributing to efficient coordination of shell and core mechanical systems with the interior design. Working on an accelerated summer schedule, Kaplan converted the building into patient-centered offices for up to 12 physicians.

Lavallee Brensinger Architects provided the interior architecture and healthcare design services for the fit-out. The building is divided into quadrants, each with exam rooms clustered around a centrally-located team room.
