

## Company of the Month: Team Simon Konover Company raises \$150,000 to benefit The Hole in the Wall Gang Camp

The Simon Konover Company (TSKC) and its Team Simon Konover raised over \$150,000 in the 2013 Camp Challenge Ride & Bandit 5K campaign to benefit The Hole in the Wall Gang Camp.

The Camp Challenge Ride & Bandit 5K is an annual charity cycling and walking event held each fall to benefit the camp.
