Southern District YMCA has partnered with Jewett Construction Company, Inc. (JCCI) to build a ground-up, new YMCA.

A volunteer YMCA facility committee is working with JCCI to design a facility that will meet the needs of the extended community and will fulfill the focus of the Y on youth development, healthy living and social responsibility.

A second phase will join an indoor pool with access through the locker rooms.
