Other plans include a large client conference center for training on Dassault SystÃ"mes 3DEXPERIENCE applications; an employee "hub" that will include a lounge and café for staff; teleconferencing capabilities; and an outdoor soccer field and basketball court.

Dassault SystÃ"mes employees will also enjoy the benefits of a new full-service fitness center at Northwoods that will include showers and locker rooms in addition to the office park's new cafeteria.

The Northwoods project for Hobbs Brook Management and Dassault SystÃ"mes SIMULIA is expected to be complete in the fall of 2014.
