

## Peabody Properties, Inc. receives recognition from National Affordable Housing Management Association for work at Pynchon Edgewater Apartments

According to Peabody Properties principal and chief operating officer, Melissa Fish-Crane, the Exemplary Family Development Community of Quality Award is a true testament to the tireless efforts of the Pynchon Edgewater Apartments management team in revitalizing the community and improving the quality of life for residents.
