Working together with business people, the town government and property owners we determined that investment in the area would be enhanced if the area was cleaned up, sidewalks and decorative lighting added and new zoning adopted. Stakeholders agreed and we got it done. Today the property values are much greater and they are holding their value. More needs to be done however there are many more stakeholders now and I am confident that they will help achieve a complete and successful revitalization.
