

C&W's team of Winters, Townsend and Reiter negotiates four leases

The team also represented Joule Biotechnologies in a new lease for 10,500 s/f at 83 Rogers St., which is part of Life Science Sq. and owned by Alexandria Real Estate Equities.

C&W negotiated a 19,093 s/f lease renewal for Ore Pharmaceuticals, the public entity at University Park at MIT, 38 Sidney St., which is owned by Forest City.

Lastly, the team also represented IntelligentMD in a new lease for 10,751 s/f at Blackstone Sq., 19 Blackstone St. and is owned by Centremark Props..
