

## Chestnut Hill Realty wins 3 awards at Rental Housing Association conference

The professional staff is attentive to residents' needs, and takes extra care in making sure that Norwood Gardens is a great place to call home. Each month the staff hosts four resident events, such as movie night on the lawn and a school supply drive to benefit local elementary schools, to build relationships and promote a sense of community.
