

BOMA Boston hosts 2014 Industry and TOBY Awards November 19

The Building Owners and Managers Association of Boston-BOMA Boston (a division of the Greater Boston Real Estate Board)-which represents over 100 million s/f of commercial real estate space in downtown and suburban Boston, hosted its annual BOMA Boston Industry and TOBY Awards on Wednesday, November 19, at the Westin Copley Place.

The Outstanding Building of the Year (TOBY) categories are separated by total square footage, and building type including: retail building, earth award, historical building, renovated building, medical building, lab building, industrial office park, and suburban low-rise. This year, BOMA Boston honored buildings in 13 different categories, covering city and suburban properties.

With over 600 registered, this was BOMA Boston's largest TOBY Awards to date! In addition to the 20 industry and TOBY awards that were presented, Scott Brown, executive vice president, Lincoln Property Company was the recipient of the Executive of the Year Award and Rob Brierley, senior vice president | real estate management services, Colliers International was awarded the first-ever President's award.

Winners from the MAC will move onto International competition at the 2015 BOMA Every Building Conference & Expo in Los Angeles in June.
