

Griffin Land leases 42,240 s/f to Pilot Freight Services in Bloomfield

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According to Griffin Land, Pilot Freight Services has signed a long-term lease for 42,240 s/f of industrial space at 40 International Dr. Construction of tenant improvements are underway, with delivery of the new and expanded facility targeted for early summer. Pilot is relocating their facilities from East Granby.

40 International Dr. is a 98,840 s/f first class industrial building. Its steel frame and masonry construction, 26-foot clear height, building systems, and abundant truck and employee parking make it a highly attractive building to modern industrial users.

"Pilot Freight Services needed to expand due to an increase in sales and logistics," said Kim Gajewski, regional vice president of Pilot Freight Services. "We wanted a state-of-the-art building to provide our customers with the best service in the industry.
