BOMA Boston raises over \$40,000 for four local beneficiaries

On Thursday, May 14, BOMA Boston hosted a check presentation for the 4 local beneficiaries recognized at this year's 26th Annual BOMA Benefit in March. Over \$40,000 was awarded to this year's beneficiaries.
