Boston mayor Marty Walsh and city councilor Tito Jackson led the ribbon-cutting ceremony before 200 attendees at the grand opening and Men's Health Summit on June 27. Dr. Gene Lindsey, president and CEO Emeritus of Atrius Health, delivered the keynote speech.
