Boston, MA On Thursday, March 23, BOMA Boston hosted a Centennial Celebration at the UMass Club, to commemorate 100 years of service in the commercial real estate industry. Over 300 members and guests attended to celebrate this special occasion and hear more about the new strategic initiatives BOMA Boston is establishing over the next several years.
