Peabody Properties honored with three 2017 PRISM Awards

In the category of Excellence in Sales/Marketing, the Peabody resident services staff at Pynchon/Edgewater Apartments in Springfield won the Gold Award for Community Spirit. Among its many community initiatives, Pynchon/Edgewater Apartments is a member of the Springfield North End Counter Criminal Continuum, or C3. The community is located in Springfield's Brightwood neighborhood, an area which has one of the greatest needs for services. Opening earlier this year, the community includes apartment homes, a college satellite, shops, restaurants, and commercial space, and has transformed the former Woolworth Building which had been vacant for over 40 years.

Recognizing an outstanding associate in the Individual and Group Achievement category, Elizabeth Merzigian, facilities manager – sustainability initiatives for Peabody Properties, won the Gold Award for Rising Star of the Year – Associate, for her work in sustainability initiatives. During her time with the Peabody Properties facilities department, Merzigian has helped to secure over \$14.5 million in zero-cost property upgrades through various utility-funded programs, while overseeing processes to help owners manage their energy costs, helping them improve efficiency and enhance building performance while focusing on long-term sustainability.
