What was your greatest professional accomplishment in 2017? Howard Stein Hudson continues to expand the Chelmsford office by providing traffic engineering services along with its growing land development civil engineering staff. We are currently at six (6) full time staff and three (3) co-ops.

What was your most notable project, deal, or transaction in 2017? The Town of Chelmsford recently went through a zoning overhaul of its industrial districts along the Rte. 129 corridor.
